



The Coon Rapids Police/Fire Departments will be distributing Child Passenger Seats from a grant received from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety –Traffic Safety.

This program is for low income Coon Rapids residents and by appointment only.

Participants will be required to watch a 15 minute video, attend a 10 minute presentation and participate in the installation of the seat in their vehicle. Total appointment takes approximately 45 minutes to an hour to complete.

Booster Seats are for children ages 4 – 8, 40 to 80 pounds, less than 4 feet 9 inches tall.

Infant/Toddler Seats are for children under age 4 and under 40 pounds.

Your installation will be assisted by a Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician.

Minnesota State Statute 169-685

Every motor vehicle operator, when transporting a child who is both under the age of eight and shorter than four feet nine inches on the streets and highways of this state in a motor vehicle equipped with factory-installed seat belts, shall equip and install for use in the motor vehicle, according to the manufacturer's instructions, a child passenger restraint system meeting federal motor vehicle safety standards.
